Thank you for your interest in our Adopt-A-Senior Program. It provides many necessary items for over 600 Clermont County senior citizens. Options for helping are listed below.

- 1. Adopt-A-Senior: Donors** (adopters) receive a Wish List completed by a senior along with their first name and ID number. The list contains suggested ideas for gifts (You are not required to purchase all gifts marked on the list). **Donors:** securely attach a large label with the name and ID # on each of the packages. Donors can drop gifts off Monday-Friday, from 9:00AM-4:15PM at the:
Main Office, 2085 James E. Sauls Sr. Dr (next to the BataviaYMCA), come in 1st building on left.
OR 9:00AM-3:15PM at the Union Township Lifelong Learning Center, located in the left hand entrance of the Union Township Civic Center, 4350 Aicholtz Road, go in to the senior center.
OR 9:00AM-3:15PM at the Miami Township Lifelong Learning Center, located **downstairs** in the Miami Township Civic Center 6101 Meijer Drive, in the Mulberry Room.
*When dropping off gifts at Union or Miami Township Centers, **please be sure to give gifts to a Clermont Senior Services staff person** so gifts can be forwarded on to the CSS Main Office.
*Gifts can be dropped off Monday through Friday only, **NO weekend drop off**.
*Please have your Donation Statement completed and ready to turn in when you drop off your gifts.
*Gifts are delivered to the seniors by registered volunteers and staff.
- 2. Purchase Gift Pantry Items:** Donors/groups purchase personal care items, cleaning supplies, plastic buckets, mops & brooms, towels & wash cloths, full & queen size sheets/pillow cases, scarves/hats/mittens/gloves/ear muffs (one size fits all), pet food (5 lb. bags or less), flashlights & hand held lanterns with batteries, all sizes of nightgowns & pajamas, bathrobes, slippers, toilet paper 4 packs, Kleenex, single rolls of paper towels, laundry detergent (32 use size or smaller), fabric softener, dish soap, liquid hand soap, hand held shower heads, bath (tub) mats, and small bags of rock salt.
- 3. Make a Cash Donation:** Proceeds will be used to purchase grocery gift cards or large tag items (mattress, lift-chair/recliner, etc.).
- 4. Donate Gift Cards:** Donors/groups purchase grocery or store gift cards that case managers give to needy seniors.

Please drop off your items no later than December 1, 2022.

If you drop off after December 1st, gifts can **only** be received at our Main Office.
